NEW Therapy Group for PARTNERS of Trans-identified or Gender-Variant Individual/s.

- *Is your spouse or partner going through a gender transition or gender identity exploration?*
- *Are you partnered with someone whose gender transition is changing the dynamics of your relationship?*
- *Do you need a safe and understanding space to express and explore your feelings about being a partner of Tran- identified or gender variant individual/s?*
- *Does your partner's gender exploration or gender expression challenge your own sexual identity or gender identity?*

If the answer to any of these questions feels like a **YES**, this group could be for you. This group (the first of its kind in Philadelphia) was created to give much-needed space to the partners of trans-identified or gender variant individuals. Our mission is to help partners explore and process their own feelings and complex emotions around being a partner of a gender variant or transgender individual/s. Often, partners of trans-identified individuals go through a parallel journey of transition and discovery. At times they may face their own identity challenges. Some folks feel isolated and alone; while others feel a sense of celebration and joy. Whatever the feelings or whatever the reason, having a safe and understanding environment where support can be found, can make all the difference. You are not alone.
